

**Ro 11:11** I say then, they did not stumble so as to fall, did they? May it never be! But by their transgression salvation has come to the Gentiles, to make them jealous.

**Ro 11:12** Now if their transgression is riches for the world and their failure is riches for the Gentiles, how much more will their fulfillment be!

**Ro 11:13** But I am speaking to you who are Gentiles. Inasmuch then as I am an apostle of Gentiles, I magnify my ministry,

**Ro 11:14** if somehow I might move to jealousy my fellow countrymen and save some of them.

**Ro 11:15** For if their rejection is the reconciliation of the world, what will their acceptance be but life from the dead?

**Ro 11:16** If the first piece of dough is holy, the lump is also; and if the root is holy, the branches are too.

**Ro 11:17** But if some of the branches were broken off, and you, being a wild olive, were grafted in among them and became partaker with them of the rich root of the olive tree,

**Ro 11:18** do not be arrogant toward the branches; but if you are arrogant, remember that it is not you who supports the root, but the root supports you.

**Ro 11:19** You will say then, “Branches were broken off so that I might be grafted in.”

**Ro 11:20** Quite right, they were broken off for their unbelief, but you stand by your faith. Do not be conceited, but fear;

**Ro 11:21** for if God did not spare the natural branches, He will not spare you, either.

**Ro 11:22** Behold then the kindness and severity of God; to those who fell, severity, but to you, God’s kindness, if you continue in His kindness; otherwise you also will be cut off.

**Ro 11:23** And they also, if they do not continue in their unbelief, will be grafted in, for God is able to graft them in again.

**Ro 11:24** For if you were cut off from what is by nature a wild olive tree, and were grafted contrary to nature into a cultivated olive tree, how much more will these who are the natural branches be grafted into their own olive tree?

**Ro 11:25** For I do not want you, brethren, to be uninformed of this mystery—so that you will not be wise in your own estimation—that a partial hardening has happened to Israel until the fullness of the Gentiles has come in;

**Ro 11:26** and so all Israel will be saved; just as it is written, “The Deliverer will come from Zion, He will remove ungodliness from Jacob.”

**Ro 11:27** “This is My covenant with them, When I take away their sins.”
